Introduction

About the College

Bongaigaon B.Ed. College, Bongaigaon is located in a scenic spot at the foothill of the renowned Bagheswari Temple, a famous Shaktipeeth connected with myriad legend and myths. A road connected with Bagheswari temple legend to the college site where one can reach there with locally available conveyances at all weather. Again Bongaigaon itself is a famous place having its manifold importance in the Lower Assam well-connected with both road and rail facilities. As to how this benign institution came into being we are to narrate a few words as below for its background and its present setup.

In the last part of the twentieth century the idea of establishing a B.Ed College at Bongaigaon haunted the minds of the senior educated professional, elites and social workers of repute in the locality at the spectacular dearth of trained teachers of the vast areas of Lower Assam in its adjacent states that deters the real standard to cope with the present situation. To materialize the concept into practice a public meeting was held on the 17 December, 1989 in the Birjhora H.S Hall under the presidentship of late Binanda Chandra Pathak, Retd. H.M of school where Sri Phani Bhushan Choudhury, MLA and our beloved young leaders spearheaded the same as convener; understanding all possible measures to start such college immediately from the next academic year 1990. Various educationists, social activist and all senior citizens joined their hands together or cater to the need of trained researches. After there were discussion besides patrons a strong Executive Body was formed in the meeting where Sri Phani Bhushan Choudhury was elected the president, Sri Lakshmi Kanta Ray as its Secretary and Sri Rajani Kanta Barman as Working Secretary. Traditionally the Bongaigaon B.Ed. College was started on August 31, 1990 in the campus of the Birjhora H.S School at the instance of 'hatch' to all other higher educational institutions since the beginning of the Bongaigaon B.Ed College, Our College got a host of able and devoted hands at the initial stage, A renowned educationalist Late Dr.Biswanath Lahiri adored the chair of the founder Principal where Late Kanak Ch.Sarma took over charges of maintaining all records and accounts of the College. Late TaraniKanta Singha undertook the various responsible works like collecting data and to assimilate some departmental works with the officials. Dr. Mrigen Das, Principal, Birjhora Mahavidyalaya convinced the then Inspector of College, G. U. Mr. B. Talukdar who was deputed to report the findings to start such college and thanks to his favourable report for which we obtained temporary affiliation from the G.U. vide Memo No. GU./Aff/2023/6949-52

Dt. 09/08/2023 of the Registrar, G.U. since then our college progressing through wear and tear of time overcoming various obstacles, either economical or academical or such other difficulties with the help and co-operation of the present management and the staff-both teaching and non-teaching. For smooth functioning of the institution and to get organized community support and involvement a Society as 'Society for Teaching Development of Schools, Bongaigaon B.Ed. College, Bongaigaon also formed. In the beginning the enormous rush of aspiring graduate and post graduates for admission compelling to select 150 trainees at the instance of the in evening shift where many working teachers also got the chance for such training. Later the NCTE came as an apex body in the field of such training on all India basis and set some terms and conditions. Of course, in the meantime we obtained six bighas of land from the Govt. To construct our own building maintaining Directions of the NCTE. Now we are to follow the directions NCTE on academic matters, management and administrative matters in day shift to carry out all norms with proper affiliation and recognition of the G. U. and NCTE respectively.

The College authority arranged recruitment of the teaching staff having requisite norms allowing state Govt. Scale of pay with various hardships depending mainly on donations and college fees etc. The MLA helps us a lot to make the road towards the college from the B.T Road available for all conveyance on all weather. However our college has overcome various obstacles by making available men and in fulfilling the hope and aspiration of the entire areas covered under its jurisdiction by the G. U. and NCTE with 100 intake capacity at present to ride on the real track having brilliant results for Years together for which we can really boast of.

Bongaigaon B.Ed College in compliance with national education policy 2020 moved forward to open B.A. (IDC) Arts Course in this college. For the same purpose the Gauhati University has accorded us permission to open the same course from the session 2021-22. Now the FIUGP for Minor Course is introduced in the Bongaigaon B.Ed. College under Gauhati University.

Location:

The College is situated in Bongaigaon, 1.5 km from Bongaigaon town in the District of Bongaigaon, Assam. According to GIS it is located at 26.40144 latitudinal and 90.567984 longitudinal positions. It is surrounded by eye- soothing landscape of nature. Beautiful tea garden is in the East and North direction.

WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 32 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993 (73 of 1993), and in supersession of the National Council for Teacher Education [Recognition Norms and Procedure] Regulations, 2009, the National Council for teacher Education has notified the Regulations, 2014 on 01.12.2014.

2. **AND WHEREAS** the institution viz. **Bongaigaon B.Ed. College, PO/ Dist. Bongaigaon, Assam -783380** was granted recognition for conduct of B.Ed. course of **one** year duration with an annual intake of **100 from the academic session 2004-2005** vide ERC order no. **ERC/7-49(ER-49.14)/2004/2916 dt. 04.10.2004.**

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution viz. Bongaigaon B.Ed. College, PO/ Dist. Bongaigaon, Assam -783380 has by affidavit dated **28.01.2015** consented to come under New Regulations 2014 and sought for **two basic units in B.Ed. course** which require additional facilities.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, it has been decided to permit the institution to have two basic units of 50 students each subject to fulfilling following conditions namely,

- (i) The institution shall create additional facilities that include (a) additional built-up area, (b) additional infrastructure, (c) additional fund, (d) adhere to staff norms as per Regulations, 2014 and inform Regional Committee with required documents by October 31, 2015.
- (ii) The applicant-institution for additional unit will be required to submit the required documents such as land documents, Encumbrance Certificate (EC), Land Use Certificate (LUC) and the Building Plan (BP) in the specified proforma available on the website to the Regional Committee in proof of having provided additional facilities before October 31, 2015. Building Completion Certificate (BCC) may be given along with other documents if available, otherwise it can also be given to the Visiting Team at the time of inspection.

(iii) The Regional Committee shall arrange for verification of documents, inspection of these premises and check adherence to these conditions by 20 Feb, 2016. If it is found by the Regional Committee that the institution fails to comply with these requirements, the institutions shall not be permitted to admit students for the academic year 2016-2017.

5. **Now therefore**, in the light of the above and in terms of Section 14(3) (a) of NCTE Act and in accordance with the Regulations, 2014, the Eastern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition to **Bongaigaon B.Ed. College, PO/ Dist. Bongaigaon, Assam -783380** for conducting **B.Ed.** Programme of **two** years duration with an annual intake of **100** for **two basic units** of 50 students each from the academic session **2015-2016** subject to fulfilment of the conditions mentioned herein before 31.10.2015.

6. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfilment of other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.

- i) The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j) The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information. If it so desires.
- k) Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
